Timeline	What Do We Do?	Structure	Helpful Tips
1 - 10 minutes (10 minutes)	Emily to review the background information and relevant documents or reports	Parents and child acclimatize the setting at the reception while Emily is reviewing the information inside	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A washroom trip will avoid the delay of the meeting. • If you need the key, please let us know. :)
11 - 30 minutes (20 minutes)	<p>Screening:</p> <p>Emily to observe and interact with the child.</p>	<p>Emily to greet the parents and the child and invite them into the center. Parents can stay in the same room but will be asked to watch from distance.</p> <p>Most of the interactions will be based on the lead of the child. If opportunities arise, the child will be observed both 1:1 and group activities.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents are asked to refrain from intervening the screening. • Only socks and indoor shoes are allowed inside. We can provide shoes cover for your outdoor shoes if you need it. Child will be in socks only. • If anyone else comes along, they can wait at the reception.
30 - 60 minutes (30 minutes)	<p>Consultation:</p> <p>Emily to share observation, overview of the clinical plan, and program information</p>	Emily to have a private meeting with the parents, while the child plays in one of the rooms under the supervision by an adult.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The children can leave first or wait for the parents.
